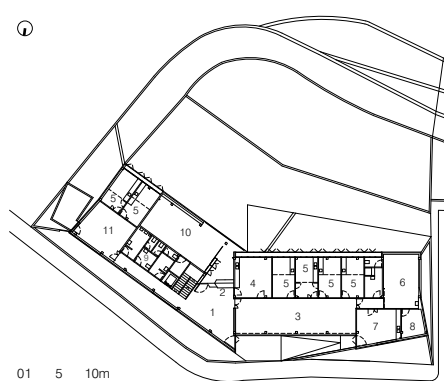


Arona-Vilaflor Medical Clinic

The Clinic is situated on the border between the small town of Arona and its rural surroundings. Its functional programme is distributed on three levels: On the first floor, with direct access from the street, we find the outpatients areas. The second floor houses the administrative and staff facility rooms, and, on the lower level, opening onto the interior garden, are the storage rooms and the staff garage.

The building is formed by two continuous skins: an exterior skin of aluminium plates, conferring it its urban presence, and an interior one, made of wood, constructing a contact surface that separates the specialized areas from the public ones.

The homogeneous exterior skin gains expression due to the discontinuities and folding of its own surface, which in turn is activated by light as a defining and dissolving element.
