




Wooden Skin unfolded

An open inside patio, or enclosed outside patio, created by the three-dimensional unfolding of the wooden surface of the enclosure, stands out as the building's main spatial point of reference, a place of interrelation and exchange where action determines the space of the representation. In the building prevails the scenic character of the skin. On the surface, the folds define a depth without thickness, which manifests itself throughout. The surface speaks through this duplicity, implying it is something it is not.




Longitudinal Section - Patio



In shaping our surrounding environment, architecture establishes a link between land and body. In the case of the Tenerife School of Dramatic Arts, the scenes of continuous representation, manifested in the flow of the building into the life of the city, are based on a particular outlook projected onto the landscape. The building is presented as a great dais, an urban stage with the city and the landscape as a backdrop, a public forum where the actors are the city-dwellers and the island plays the role of background scenery. A dais which has been removed from its usual context – the codified theatre building – and brought closer to the elements of everyday life: the street, the city, the mountains and the sea.
